


#### **TULA SARSONS**

# BEHIND THE SCENES



### CATHERINE HANDFORD – Costume Coordinator

Catherine has been passionate about sewing and costume design since childhood. Now based in Calgary, she has enjoyed creating for many community theatre companies and is delighted to contribute to New York, New York with 42<sup>nd</sup> Street Productions. She thanks her family for their patience and support throughout her creative process.

Chance Devlin - Piano, Vocals, Arrangements, Band Leader

Chance is happy to be back collaborating on the fifth New York New York Show together since the first one back in 2003. Chance cried crocodile tears in Grade Three, until his parents got him a piano & a teacher. He promptly quit piano lessons, instead teaching himself music with vinyl records borrowed from the Calgary Public Library plucking out one note at a time. His first gig was as a bandleader, not a soloist, in 1997 forming the "the Livin' In Swing Orchestra" for the grand opening of the Lodge of the Ten Peaks in Lake Louise, which led to a weekly show "Swing Night at the Palace" in Calgary. As the gigs started coming in, he had to quickly learn how to write out full band arrangements and direct a big party orchestra from behind the piano, earning local notoriety as a top corporate & wedding band. He numbered band arrangements from 1 to 900.. and memorized the number for each song so he could be spontaneous and play what feels right in each new moment at the party. In 2001 Chance was the first to bring dueling pianos to Calgary, and still performs often with his group "Rowdy Pianos" for special event. Pandemic led to more solo work and international performing. Chance still loves band leading, but is now most often found at the piano alone with just a microphone, and no set list or show plan to slow him down.



#### BENTIZZARD - Guitars

Ben holds a Bachelor of Music Degree in Jazz Guitar from Ambrose University, and has had the privilege of studying with renowned Calgary musicians such as Ralf Bushmeyer, Neil McVey, Aaron Young, and Aaron Shorr. With over 15 years of experience playing the guitar, Ben has honed his skills and developed a unique musical style that incorporates a plethora of musical genres. His musical journey continues with the release of his 3rd project titled "What Christmas Was," a genre bending- nostalgic trip to the holiday past. This 5 track EP showcases his talent and creativity, and he is thrilled to share his work with the world.



#### RUBEN BOCARANDA - Drums, Percussion & Second MD

Ruben Bocaranda is a seasoned drummer and musical director known for building bands and producing unforgettable live shows. With a background spanning classical, jazz, rock, pop, Latin, and R&B, Ruben brings a rich understanding of musical styles to his work, successfully expanding his band concepts to Canada, the U.S., Germany, and China.





Upon High School Graduation, Brandon attended the University of Calgary to study Saxophone with Dr. Jeremy Brown. While attending he performed in the University wind ensemble, Red Band Jazz Band and the "Super Sax" Group "Saxophonee". Brandon also became involved with the Calgary music scene performing with the Calgary Philharmonic Orchestra, Wednesday Night Big Band, and the Prime Time Big Bands. During these years he began doing numerous Saxophone, Flute and Clarinet clinics for Junior and Senior High Schools and taught private lessons a the Bearspaw School of Fine Arts and his own studio. After receiving his Bachelor of Music Brandon became a sought after private teacher, clinician, and performer in Southern Alberta. During the 1990's Brandon did several contracts with Royal Caribbean Cruise lines and Norwegian Cruise lines performing with the Show Bands and Jazz Combos. Over the past 32 years he has also performed with several Local Bands including the Barry Shaw Orchestra and Unique" MD Ben Rose and Cafe Rose", "The Madison Boxa Band", "Hot Cargo", "20/20", "Worlds Best Wedding Band", "TR3", "The Calgary Jazz Orchestra", and "Urban Divide". He has also performed in the New York Musical Theatre Festival on Broadway Playing the Woodwind Chair for "What Do Critics Know?" in 2015. Brandon is currently the Director of the Fox Big Band. From 2001-2004 Brandon was the Saxophone instructor at Red Deer College as well as Red Deer's "Adventures in Music Summer Camp. Brandon also taught saxophone Mount Royal Universities Summer Saxophone Camp and the Head Start Summer Band Camp. For the past fourteen years Brandon has been the Jazz Director at St. Francis High School in Calgary, AB. He also has been the Director of the Calgary Summer Jazz Camp for the last 20 years. Brandon Oberhamer has performed in virtually every type of setting and has now released three albums, The Smooth Jazz album "The Oberhamer Brothers" Together Again, another of sacred Hymns entitled "Beautiful Savior" and one of classic Christmas Carols "Christmas Peace" with Pianist Marvin Goldstein. He is also on the Fox Big Band Album Featuring Benny Benack III as MD and Lead Alto Sax.



### SARAH DENNISON – Trumpet



Dr. Sand has also presented masterclasses and clinics at hundreds of high schools, colleges and universities throughout North America. In addition to trumpet, Dr. Sand has studied and taught voice, conducting and music education at several institutions. Additional studies include seminars at Northwestern University, Raphael Méndez Brass Institute, Aspen Music Festival, Music Academy of the West as Fellow, Chosen Vale Center for Advanced Musical Studies, the Los Angeles Philharmonic, USC, and the Banff Centre. Dr. Sand holds degrees from the University of Alberta, McGill University, University of Victoria, Yale University and is a certified teacher.

### IHOR KOLOMIJCHUK – Bass




### SERHII HATSELIUK – Drums & Percussion

After completion of the two-year program, Stefano immersed himself into the L.A. music scene and as a freelance musician for live performances and studio sessions. It was at this time that he joined the Grove School of Music Faculty, assisting noted music educator Mark Harrison in the General Musicianship and Small Group Arranging classes. As Stefano's reputation as an educator grew, in 1996 he joined Harrison School of Music as Bass Program coordinator. At the same time, he kept refining his instrumental skills by taking private lessons with bassists Miroslav Vitous, Dave Holland, and Jeff Berlin and Joel Dibartolo. While at CSULB, he taught theory and ear training classes for the Undergraduate Program and continued to produce, record and perform for numerous independent projects.
